[ 0 : 00 ] Thank you for gathering us together, and thank you for condescending to mankind and redeeming us through the blood of your son Jesus.

! And I don't understand the incarnation, but I'm thankful that it's true.! I thank you, Lord, for redeeming us at your great expense and mercy and your grace. And then you gave us your word, and you tell us something about yourself.

And it is that that we hope to learn this morning, Lord. Help us to encourage one another and to pay attention to your word.

It's in Jesus' name we pray. Amen. Amen. So we left Jacob and Esau, so we're going back to them. Now, this is chapter 27, beginning with verse 41. That's where we left off. And so we're going to see a little bit. I'm going to learn a little lesson about myself. I don't like that lesson.

[ 1 : 30 ] But I'm going to learn a little lesson about myself, about what it means to blame others for my own doings. And we'll look at that a little bit this morning.

Chapter 27, beginning with verse 41. If you read those, oh, first six verses there. It'll give us a launch.

So, what's Esau thinking about Jacob at this time? I'm sorry. I thought I heard.

He hates him. How much does he hate him? Yeah. And not in a fit of rage. He's planning it out.

He's angry, but what's he saying? He's going to die pretty soon. Yeah, dad's old. He's going to die pretty soon. And after the time of mourning, then what am I going to do?

[ 2 : 44 ] I'm going to kill Jacob. Well, that's a pretty big deal. Now, why is he going to do that?

Okay. What's he angry about? Is that it?

Okay. So, he said he took what? He took my birthright and my blessing. Now, hang on a minute.

Okay. I never have done this. But I've known people who did.

Well, it's the officer's fault that I got caught for speeding. Why are you stopping me from doing this?

[ 4 : 06 ] I didn't do anything wrong. Well, you stole from the store. That's justice shopping. You see, Esau sold his birthright.

I mean, that was his own doing, wasn't it? But who's he blaming? Jacob. I decide that I'm going to, I really want this automobile.

And I want it so badly because of the way it looks. It really looks cool. It's on blocks, but it looks fast. But who do I blame for making a bad deal? The guy who sold it to me or something like that. So, there are many ways that I can maneuver that, but it was Esau's fault.

It was Esau's fault. Now, the blessing, that's another matter. We don't know that it was Esau's fault.

[ 5 : 25 ] We know that there was family division. I mean, right from the beginning, right from the beginning, we read that Isaac loved Esau and Rebekah loved Jacob.

So, there's family division right in the beginning there. Nevertheless, God had ordained at, before the birth, that the blessing or the promise to Abraham is going to be carried through Isaac and from Isaac to Jacob.

So, Jacob is going to be the one that's going to carry the Abrahamic promise. Now, and by the way, these are the three names that we associate, well, I say we, God, associates regularly to Israel.

I am the God of? Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. Right. And in fact, the Lord Jesus is going to correct the Sadducees on this point.

He's the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. And then Jesus is going to say, he's not the God of the dead.

[ 7 : 02 ] He's the God of the living. See, this was totally unplanned, as you can see, obviously.

Incidentally, in the whole of the Gospels, or the synoptics, Matthew, Mark, Luke, and you see it in John as well.

Now, it's very interesting, because the Sadducees and the Pharisees did not get along. They were miles apart. The Sadducees largely controlled the priesthood at the time that Jesus walked the earth.

The Pharisees saw themselves as the guardians of the true religion, of course, as did the Essenes, but they're not mentioned as often.

[ 8 : 05 ] But it's funny, isn't it, how they united against Jesus Christ. They conspired together, even though they hated one another.

That was interesting to me. At any rate, back to the real point. So, when Esau lost the birthright, what did he lose in terms of this life?

The double portion. He lost a big temporal blessing. Did he not? And he wanted the blessing from Jacob because he wanted the blessing from Isaac, from his father, because he wanted temporal blessings.

How should I, as a Christian in this age of grace, view temporal blessings? Yeah, that's a trick question, isn't it?

No, how should I view it? I should be thankful. Thankful for what? Okay, I should be primarily thankful for my eternal blessing.

[ 9 : 36 ] In fact, the church, God says, whether I realize it or not, or whether I allow myself to see it or not, or whether, no matter if I comprehend it, God says, you are blessed with every spiritual blessing in the heavenlies.

Now, that's wonderful for the spiritual and eternal blessings. And it's very important. But what about the temporal blessings?

Okay, what's that mean? What's a steward?

Could be an ambassador at some times. Abraham's steward was an ambassador when he got Rebecca for Isaac.

An accountant. An accountant. An accountant. More than, he's the chief financial officer.

[ 10 : 57 ] He manages. Okay, so a steward manages. Who owns, who owns the car? Now, what do I say?

That's my car. Is it really my car? It's really God's car. And I'm the manager of it.

Because he says, you're going to give the account. So, but, should then I say, let me ask you, if God owns everything and we are stewards, should we, let me, should we say, well, I'm going to live in a cardboard box under the bridge so that all the money can go to other work?

Is that a reasonable assumption? You may not have heard it, but I have heard people that have tried to put guilt trips on the church before about, well, here you sit in all your comfort and...

You've never heard that? Now, can I overdo my comforts?

[ 12 : 35 ] Sure. Is what I do with my finances critical to my eternal security?

No. Where's my righteousness come from? Jesus Christ. I can't be good enough.

I can't give enough away. I can't sacrifice enough to be justified before God.

Because I'm a sinner in nature. For all die for that all have sin.

So, why do I get decrepit and why do I die? Because of sin. Now, not because of an individual sin, but sin is in the world.

[ 13 : 45 ] We're in a fallen world. It's broken. And Roger mentioned it earlier this morning before class started. The whole creation does what?

Groans. Groans. Because of the subjection to the curse. Who subjected it? No.

Who cursed it? God did. Now, and here comes my lack of understanding of God's glory and glorification.

But he says that the whole creation groans until he reveals the redemption of the church before not just us, but angelic beings.

so, before principalities and powers, he's going to display his glories. So, when he reveals the redemption of the church, the curse then, that's why creation's subjected for now.

[ 15 : 02 ] so that we, partly, so that the magnitude of sin I don't comprehend. The affront to God that the whole crash of sin and rejection of God has brought.

But we see in Romans chapter 1 that mankind's tendency is to deny God.

Now, that's, is it mankind's tendency not to think there's a God? No, it says that he suppresses the truth.

So, mankind's tendency is not so much that he doesn't understand there's a God, it's that he doesn't want there to be a God. That's the big issue, isn't it, in Romans chapter 1.

Therefore, all the tragedies we see perpetrated in the world are a result of mankind's refusal to acknowledge God as God. So, that's pretty important for me to remember.

[16:24] Roger. If you think man has a tendency to want to follow somebody, either themselves or another person, or a creature, creator, something?

Let's do a little parable You're raising sheep You get a hole in the fence And the bell sheep, the bell ewe She finds that hole You get up tomorrow morning How many sheep are in your field?

None Why? We tend to do that, don't we? All we like sheep have gone astray And turned everyone Now I know that's a little That's a little stretch and a little You know, there There are some of us that want to follow the leader And then there are some of us that want to be the bell ewe And But There is a tendency to follow something And We do definitely In the We do serve someone, don't we?

We're going to serve Christ Or we're going to serve Satan We can say ourselves But that's the whole point of it You won't really die You won't really die God knows that In the day you eat of this fruit You'll be Like God's Knowing good and evil So That is There is a tendency of rebellion Yes Yes Okay Back to the temporal blessings What was Paul's Approach To the temporal blessings?

I'm sorry? Well As far as his own righteousness They were rags Whether it was his doings Or his possessions That's true In Okay Let's try Philippians I'm I know I'm jumping into it Philippians chapter 4 But this was written a long time before I knew that Philippians chapter 4 Breeze through there And A church has sent Paul An envoy with money Support What's he say?

[19:24] Okay Okay What's the key To temporal blessings?

You Before you answer Let me ask Or let me throw out This Wrinkle You know someone Who looks around And sees someone Who has it better And says That should be me And I should have that Or Why don't I have that?

You know someone Who has said I don't believe in God Because I prayed for This or that Usually it's for a healing for grandma or something And God didn't give it to me Well I really needed a car But God didn't give it to me As though my rejection of God Is going to unseat him from his throne That's not going to happen Is it?

Okay Back to the Back to the point Because There are Christians Who don't have much We just There are Christians Who are going hungry There are Christians Who don't have the blessings that we have In North America In fact Very Most Probably Don't have the blessings we have in North America Temporal blessings The comforts that we have And the And Readily available food And that kind of thing Okay So what's Paul say About that Gift Okay So what's that mean?

Does he He said I know how to live With a lot I'm sorry about the misuse of that term That's not a lot of land A plot It's a I know how to be In wealth And I know how to live in want And what does he say about that?

[22:00] I have Learned That It doesn't come by nature to me Does it? The nature of man is Self-centered Is it not?

Who has to teach The child To say Give me Who has to teach that? I knew that Before I knew how to Articulate it Didn't I?

Okay So Paul says I have learned How to be Content With whatever I have And sometimes The Lord gives me a lot As now You've given me this gift Sometimes I'm in what?

Specifically What Does She Say To Jacob Shiloh Okay Okay How Does She Word It Stay With Laban What Yes Stay With Laban A Few Days Somebody Help Me With How Many Days That Turned Out To Be At Least 14 Years About 7300 Days
